## Tour Group Confirmation

**Day of Arrival Tour Tips:** On the day of the tour, kindly unload the bus or motorcoach on the west side of the building at the bus loading area. Restroom facilities are available in the small building behind the Depot. If your group is scheduled for a guided tour or program, Docents will meet/ receive you at this location. Plan to arrive at least one-half hour before your scheduled tour time to allow everyone to use the facilities. Guests are free to browse the gift shop while waiting for their group members.

Once the group has reformed, the docent(s) will escort the group to the orientation area. After a short introduction Guests are free to enjoy the exhibits.

**Parking:** Complimentary parking is available for cars, motorcoaches and school buses. Motorcoaches and school buses are asked to proceed to the parking lot on Fifth Street once guests have disembarked. When tour is complete guests can either walk to the bus at the parking lot or buses can pick guests up on the north side of the Depot on Third Street.

**Food Service:**

Picnic tables are available outside on a first-come, first-serve basis. Food and drinks are not allowed inside the museum.

**Museum Rules:** Chaperones please stay with your group throughout the visit. Photography is permitted. Food, drinks, gum, or smoking are permitted outside only.

**Special Arrangements:** Call for information about accessibility for persons with disabilities. All areas of the museums are wheel chair accessible.

**Tour Cancellation:** If you book a reservation for your group and are unable to make the trip, please give notice of cancellation immediately. We have a waiting list and, as a courtesy to those groups, we ask you to contact us as soon as possible.

**Chaperone Policy:** We require one adult chaperone for every ten students. Chaperones please stay with your group throughout the visit.

### **How to get to the Historic Katy Depot —**

The Sedalia Katy Depot is located about six blocks east of downtown Sedalia. It is easily accessible by vehicle, or Amtrak train.

### **By Vehicle:**

**From Highway 50** go to Hancock Street. Turn north to Third Street and turn west to the Katy Depot.

**From South Highway 65** go to Third Street and turn east (right) where the Katy Depot will be located on your right about 24 blocks down, on the southeast corner of Third and Thompson Streets.

**From North Highway 65** take the 765 exit which becomes Ohio Avenue. Take Ohio Avenue to Third Street and turn east (left) where the Katy Depot will be located on your right about six blocks down, on the southeast corner of Third and Thompson Streets.

### **By Amtrak train:**

Amtrak trains stop at the Sedalia station (corner of Ohio Avenue and Pacific Street). After leaving the train walk east to Ohio Avenue (the first street). Turn south (right) and walk four blocks to Third Street, and turn east (left) where the Katy Depot will be located on your right about six blocks down, on the southeast corner of Third and Thompson Streets.
